NFF provides follow-up coaching between day one and day two of the Clinic and offers customized technical assistance after completion.

Participation Needs

Nonprofit Finance Fund's Financial Leadership Clinic is open to small to mid-sized nonprofits with operating budgets between \$250,000 and \$3 million.

For the FLC to be most effective for your organization, Nonprofit Finance Fund asks for the participation of the Executive Director and a senior finance staff member for both days, and for the participation of a Board Member for the morning of the second day.
